### Legal Training Module



#### Content

Setting up a business in a new country or moving an existing business to another jurisdiction is always challenging. Many people have limited knowledge about the legal grounds.

Within the project on ‘Financial Inclusion for Refugees and Host Communities in Turkey’, we as Sparkassenstiftung prepared the Legal Training Module to support potential and existing entrepreneurs about business law in Turkish system.

In this respect, this module aims to provide legal guidance to the target group in their commercial and entrepreneurial activities. The module includes basic technical information about business law in the Turkey system and all related regulations.

In addition to this knowledge, the module is designed to equip participants with a working understanding of business and company law relating to: contracts, required licenses and permits, organization types, tax requirements and so on/ etc.

During the face to face training and coaching seminars all related topics are supported through practical case studies. The course will be delivered by lawyers and/or legal experts that are experienced with assisting small and medium entrepreneurial ventures.
